


JOB ALTERNATIVES FOR WOMEN

*** Average number of years women spend working outside the home:**

- married with children - 34 yr.
- married without children - 38 yr.
- single woman - 48 yr.

*** Women have to work more than 8 days to earn same amount as men do in 5 days**

*** 62.7% of women working for pay are in clerical, sales or service jobs**
